A BRIEF HISTORY



In the early hours of Christmas Day 1974, Tropical Cyclone Tracy struck Darwin with devastating high winds and torrential rainfall causing massive destruction of buildings and services and a death toll of 65. "Tracy Village" was established on a RAAF base on the outskirts of Darwin to provide housing and support amenities for the reconstruction workers who came from many parts of Australia.

Tracy Village Social Club was founded in 1975 to provide a Clubroom for those workers and Darwin residents and later built sports facilities, affiliated with eight sports Clubs and became Tracy Village Social and Sports Club.

The Club has over 5000 Members and welcomes bona-fide guests from every part of Australia and is proud of it's reputation as a friendly, family orientated Club.
