Dunes and Greene 200ml South Australia

Delicate aromas of lemon zest, fresh strawberries and cream.

Pale blush in colour, Dunes & Greene is a full flavoured sparkling wine with a refined finish.

Stonehaven Stepping Stone Sparkling Limestone Coast

Zesty and light, fruity flavours of apple, pear, and apricot with notes of blossom.

Redbank Sunday Morning Prosecco NV King Valley

This dry and fresh Prosecco has hints of pear, honeycomb and granny smith apples.

The palate is subtly sweet and finely balanced by natural acidity, typical chalky texture and a light savoury finish.

The nose displays aromas of honeysuckle, citrus zest and fresh strawberries. The palate is balanced with a refreshing natural acidity. The finish is dry and fresh with lingering flavours of citrus and nougat.

The aroma is an enticing mix of pink roses, fresh strawberries and musk.

With flavours of exotic tropical fruits, the palate is delightfully light and fresh.

Intensely refreshing and zesty, flavours of passionfruit and peach with hints of gooseberry.

The finish is long, dry and clean.

Wirra Wirra Hiding Champion Sauvignon Blanc Adelaide Hills

Lifted zesty aromas of star fruit, feijoa, gardenia, grapefruit, snow pea and nashi pear.

Flavours of mandarin and freshly squeezed citrus, red-fleshed guava, with hints of white florals and crunchy pea shoots.

Dandelion Vineyards Fairytale of the Barossa Rosé Barossa

Aromatically alluring and unavoidable. Clean and further bright and uplifting. A side-hustle of grip and texture, but this quality - whilst essential to the overall balance - is very much off-RADAR. A water-like weight and quality, but then the acidity kicks in, drawing out this pink wine to a long finish.

Stonehaven Stepping Stone Shiraz Limestone Coast

Gorgeously styled and perfumed with sweet plum, blackberry, toasty oak and cake spice aromas. Rich and bold, flavours of sweet red fruits, blackberry, and touches of pepper spice. Silky and generous with plenty of flavours.

Wirra Wirra Catapult Shiraz McLaren Vale

Bright mulberry and raspberry with a lovely nutmeg and allspice layer. The palate is dense with vibrant fleshy blue fruits and mulberry compote and a background of baking spices. Refined cocoa powder tannins finish off the wine with style.

Wirra Wirra Church Block Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz Merlot McLaren Vale

Classic blackberry, leaf and briar of Cabernet Sauvignon are closely pursued by opulent plums and wild herbs of Shiraz and Merlot. A wealth of cassis, plums and black cherries are tethered to the palate with smartly ripened tannin.

Jim Barry Cover Drive Cabernet Sauvignon South Australia

The nose leads with aromas of fresh tobacco leaf, cassis, boysenberry and spice. A silk like entry on the palate with super fine, detailed tanning, ripe berried fruits, a hint of tobacco and the classic brambles of Clare Cabernet to finish.

Heirloom Adelaide Hills Pinot Noir Adelaide Hills

A fresh and vibrant mouthful of exuberant pinot noir pushes forth, but then the darker berry fruit flavours take over and make the wine coil into a dense and boldly tannic crush. Another sip and another surprise as the wine then revives and flowers.
